



## **'SCORCHED' ADDS LOGIE NOMINATION TO GROWING AWARDS RECOGNITION**

**Scorched**, the ratings-winning tele-feature and multi-platform drama set in a future Sydney ravaged by drought and bushfires, has followed its recent International Digital Emmy nomination with a nomination in the 2009 Logie Awards.

**Scorched** has been nominated for a TV WEEK SILVER LOGIE Award in the Most Outstanding Drama Series, Miniseries or Tele-movie Award.

**Scorched**, produced by Goalpost Pictures Australia and Essential Media and Entertainment, in association with Firelight Productions, screened on the Nine Network in August 2008 to more than 1.125 million viewers.
